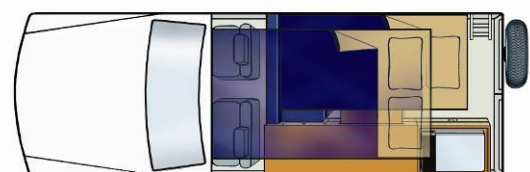
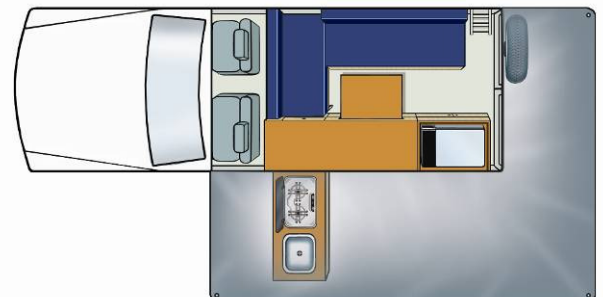


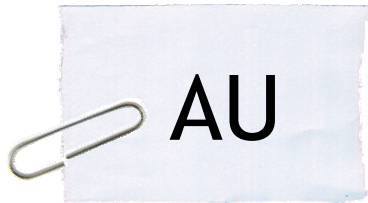
Outback comfort for two
